??? Church Children / Youth Ministry Volunteer Policies

To insure the safety and welfare of all students and volunteers, the following policies and regulations are a part of our volunteer commitment while serving with **??? Church Children/Youth Ministry activities and retreats.**

- There will be no use of alcohol or illegal use of drugs.
- There will be no inappropriate sexual behavior among volunteers and/or students.
- There will be no firearms, knives, fireworks, or weapons of any kind.
- Volunteers are expected to treat all students and parents equally and with the highest respect and dignity.
- All volunteers are on call and required to remain with students while on **???** property or grounds visited on trips.
- Volunteers are subject to the completion of a satisfactory background check if requested by church. Please attach a copy of a valid photo ID.
- Volunteers working more than 3 hours a month with minors are required to complete Safe Church Training Level 2 by the Diocese of NC.
- Volunteers are asked to be cautious of social media networks by not providing inappropriate pictures or comments for **???** Church children/youth to view. Volunteers should not request information from

children/youth including “friend request” or “follow” invitations. Students may initiate requests only. It is your discretion to accept requests from children/youth.

- Volunteers should not post pictures of children/youth on social network sites with identification. No photos of children/youth in swimsuits or sleepwear should be posted.
- Volunteers should always receive parental permission before hanging out with children/youth outside of church activities. This includes driving a children/youth home from events.
- Volunteers driving children/youth should not use cell phones while the vehicle is in motion.
- Volunteers are encouraged to limit email and text to the whole group and not individual children/youth. Volunteers should not text or email with children/youth between the hours of 10:30pm and 5:30am.
- Volunteers are not permitted to administer any form of medication, prescription, or over-the-counter, to any children/youth during an event unless you are designated to handle the community medical needs for a given event.
