

Standing Committee: Report Q4 2020

During the fourth quarter of 2020, The Standing Committee of the Diocese of North Carolina:

- Consented to episcopal election in the Diocese of Wyoming
- Reviewed its work on Becoming Beloved Community / Anti-White Supremacy efforts, including participating in a follow-up Anti-White Supremacy Workshop conducted by The Rev. Jabriel Ballentine on October 19. Work continues on three themes identified in the 2019 workshop: (1) access to power structures (specifically Standing Committee and Diocesan Council), (2) unequal distribution of funds, and (3) worship.
- Reaffirmed their recommendation for ordination to the priesthood the following: Laura Rezac, Matt Addington, Rebecca Ogus, Andrew Ancona, Paul Daniels, Lizzie McManus-Dail, Joe Sroka and Caitlyn Darnell.
- Recommended for ordination to the vocational diaconate the following: Joe Dzugan, Kristin Edrington, Maureen Flak and Pamela Haynes
- Approved the sale of a residential structure by Grace, Lexington to Habitat for Humanity
- Approved the sale of a portion of land at St. Stephen's, Oxford
- Approved the transfer of real property from the Diocese to St. Titus, Durham, since they attained parish status
- Approved the transfer of real property from the Diocese to Trinity, Fuquay-Varina, since they attained parish status
- Elected three members for the term ending 2023: Mr. Marcus Clarke, The Rev. Nancy Cox, Ms. Septina Florimonte
- Acted as Council of Advice for The Rt. Rev. Sam Rodman
